HOUSE AND CANTEEN RULES/ BYLAWS

- I. Only paid up members and guests may buy drinks at the bar.
- II. Current membership cards will be required and must be shown if requested by the bartender when alcohol is purchased.
- III. Any person considered intoxicated by the bartender will be served no more alcohol, and if necessary, asked to leave the Post.
- IV. The bartender will abide by the posted bar hours, unless he or she deems it appropriate to stay open longer.
- V. All beverages will be purchased at the bar and no outside beverages are allowed.
- VI. All beverages must be consumed inside the building or within the confines of the designated outside area.
- VII. Any person(s) engaging in conversation leading to an argument will be asked to leave the Post, and if necessary, be charged under Article IX after review by the Executive Committee.
- VIII. Any harassment by any person(s) is prohibited, and if necessary, the offender may be charged under Article IX after review by the Executive Committee.
- IX. Foul language will not be tolerated at Post #135.
- X. Under section 2 of Article IV of the bylaws of the American Legion, members may be suspended or expelled from the American Legion. Charges shall be based upon conduct unbecoming a member of the American Legion. The Executive Committee shall review all cases. If charges are to be filed, the Commander shall act as Judge Advocate and order a writ be issued by the Post Adjutant.
 - A) 1st offense: Up to a six month suspension.
 - B) 2nd offense: Up to a permanent suspension.
